FOUNDATION / PREP ENROLMENT 2027

YEAR 6 TO 7 TRANSITION 2026-2027

Last term the Year 6's received their Year 7 Secondary School Placement Letter. Parents/Carers will also shortly receive a welcome letter from the Secondary School. Parents/carers may lodge an appeal with their preferred secondary school. The Appeal Form was sent home with families and was to be lodged with the preferred secondary school by Friday, 17th July.

Year 7 Placement Acceptance Slips must be returned to your child's teacher by Tuesday, 11th August 2026.

If you have applied to a private school, please notify our office when you have a confirmed place so that we can notify your child's zoned government secondary college.

CYBER SAFETY FOR OUR STUDENTS.

We are having a serious need to follow up events that have originated online - over holidays, over the weekends or overnight. We can only ask that online communications are monitored by all parents, so that they can see and hear all the comments that are being made between students. Some are positive, suitable and age appropriate. However, there are many that are not and they can be very hurtful and potentially harmful to mental health. These are the ones that continue over the school day and can impact learning and play significantly.

We have some parents that have expressed their concern, with the negative effect it is having on the wellbeing of their children. This is involving both boys and girls. We thank you for your ongoing support with this matter. The platforms of most concern that our underage students are using are Twitch, Tik Tok, Instagram, Roblox and Fortnite, among others. Live streaming in an unmonitored space, can be a real risk for our primary age students. Some students report that they receive money as a result of their streaming activities.

Navigating these spaces safely is an eSafety priority, with many government and support organizations offering targeted resources to help parents manage risks. For guidance on setting up parental controls and understanding online risks, you can visit the eSafety Commissioner Gaming Guide.
